65(a)(1) - I support the changes in this section. 65(b)(1)(A) and (B) - The proposed changes to the thresholds are much more reasonable approach to define critical gas volumes. 65(c) - I support removing the confidential supply chain map requirements. 65(e)(1) and (2) - I think there should be exemptions allowed and administratively handled by staff with technical knowledge.
