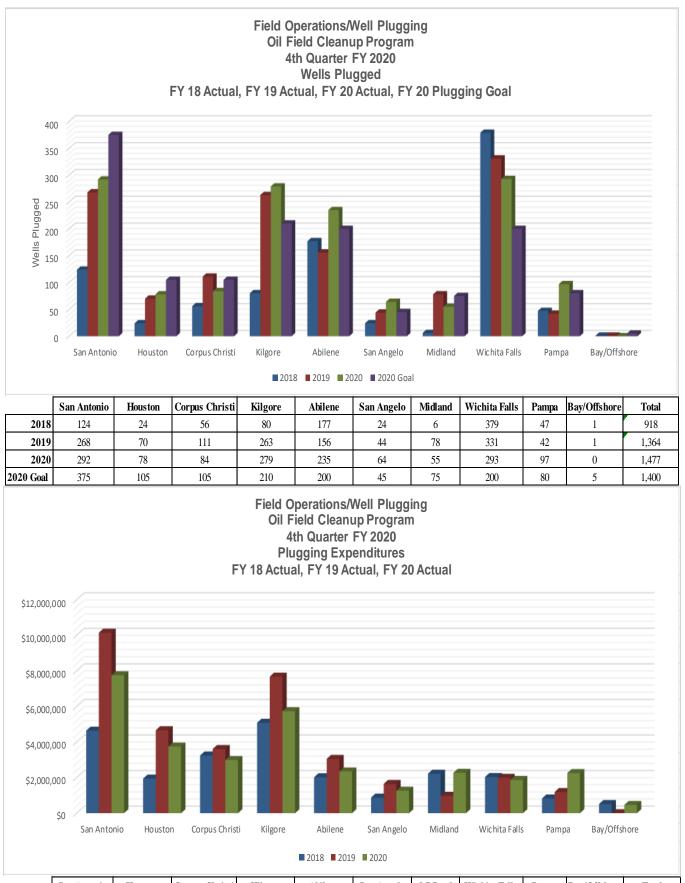
SUBJECT: Oil Field Cleanup Program Quarterly Status Report, Fiscal Year 2020, 4th Quarter

Well Plugging: The 4th quarter performance for State-Managed Plugging includes 445 wells plugged with a total expenditure of \$9,006,382.25 using Oil and Gas Regulation and Cleanup (OGRC) and Economic Stabilization funds. This includes wells that have been physically plugged, invoiced by the plugging contractor, and approved for payment by Field Operations. Additionally, during the 4th quarter, 566 wells were approved for plugging with State funds. A total of 1498 wells were physically plugged through the end of the 4th quarter, of which, 1477 have been invoiced and paid. The actual wells plugged and expenditure by district for fiscal years 2018, 2019 and 2020 and the well plugging goals and budgets by district for fiscal year 2020 are shown on the attached graphs. The fiscal year 2020 budget is \$42,281,610.

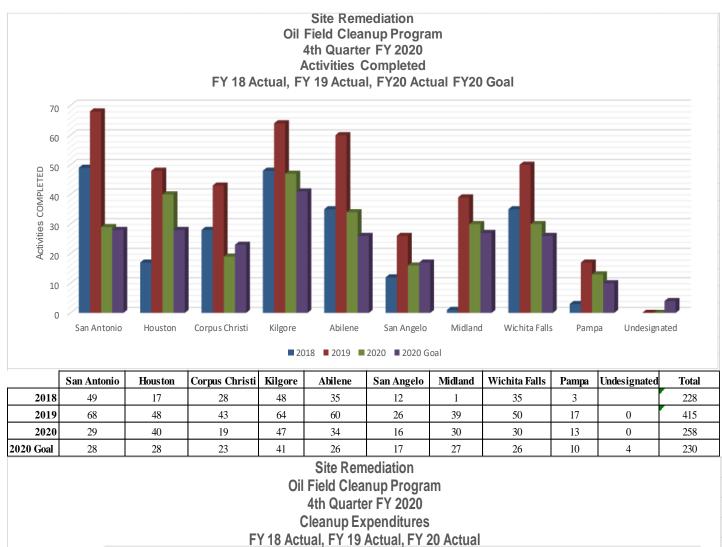
Site Remediation: The 4th quarter performance for Site Remediation includes 67 cleanup activities completed with total expenditure of \$6,411,753.00 using OGRC funds. There were three activities completed with expenditure of \$62,769.00 using Grant Funds. During the 4th quarter 35 cleanup activities were authorized for cleanup with State funds. Site Remediation has completed and formally closed a total of 253 cleanup activities using OGRC funds and five activities with Grant Funds for a total of 258 completed activities during fiscal year 2020. The actual remediation activities and expenditure by district for fiscal years 2018, 2019, and 2020 and the goals for the Site Remediation activities by district for fiscal year 2020 are shown on the attached graphs. The fiscal year 2020 budget is \$17,150,000.00.

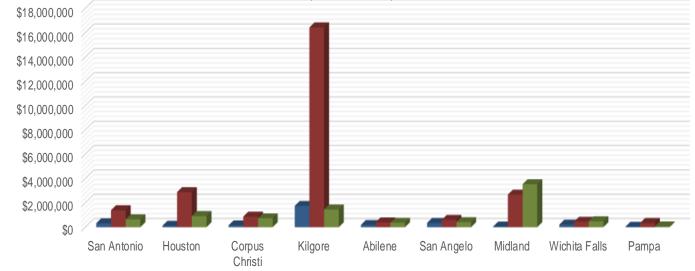
