Under section 9.101 of the *LP-Gas Safety Rules*, the storage must be approved by AFS. Under Section 9.103 of the *LP-Gas Safety Rules* you are given the right to object to this proposed installation. All objections must be addressed to AFS at the address indicated on Page 2 of this form. AFS may consider amended objections received from affected parties should subsequent information be filed by the applicant. AFS files are open records, and you may order a copy of the *LP-Gas Safety Rules* from the division or you may view and print these rules from our website at www.rrc.texas.gov. All objections must be received no later than 18 days after the day of mailing this notice. Objections are considered received by the Railroad Commission of Texas on the day of actual receipt-NOT on the day of mailing. You may state any objections to a proposed installation must include a statement alleging either (A), (B), or (C) below, and contain supporting facts. Please check the applicable statement below and provide supporting facts or any comments on Page 2 of this form.

- (A) I object on the basis of noncompliance with the *LP-Gas Safety Rules*, with reference to the particular rule(s) relied upon.
- (B) I object on the basis of noncompliance with the statutes of the State of Texas, with reference to the particular provision relied upon.
- (C) I object on the basis of facts which indicate that the proposed installation constitutes a danger to the public health, safety, and welfare, specifying the exact nature of the danger. "Danger" means an imminent threat or an unreasonable risk of bodily harm, but does not mean a diminished property or esthetic value.
 - (D) I have no objection regarding the proposed installation described above.

Under the provisions of the *LP-Gas Safety Rules*, if proper objections to a proposed installation are filed, a hearing on the installations proposed is required to be held. A hearing will determine whether the installation, as designed, meets all rules and regulations of the Railroad Commission of Texas, all applicable statutes of the State of Texas, and whether it constitutes a danger to the public health, safety and welfare. These are the only areas of inquiry which will be addressed. In order for this form to be considered, it must be dated and signed in ink by the addressee or duly authorized agent of the addressee.
