State of Disaster in Texas Waiver Requests

On March 13, Governor Greg Abbott declared a State of Disaster in Texas for all Texas counties in response to the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. During the State of Disaster, individuals required to be certified as a transport driver for the safe transportation of liquefied petroleum gas (LPG and propane) have been issued a waiver for certain regulatory requirements from the Railroad Commission of Texas (RRC). The waiver allows transport drivers to operate a transport registered to a licensed company without taking the transport driver certification exam. Once the State of Disaster declaration concludes all drivers must take and pass the required certification exam prior to resuming activities requiring certification.

Remember, the RRC also maintains a 24-hour, toll free emergency line; 844-773-0305 to report leaks, spills and other incidents.
