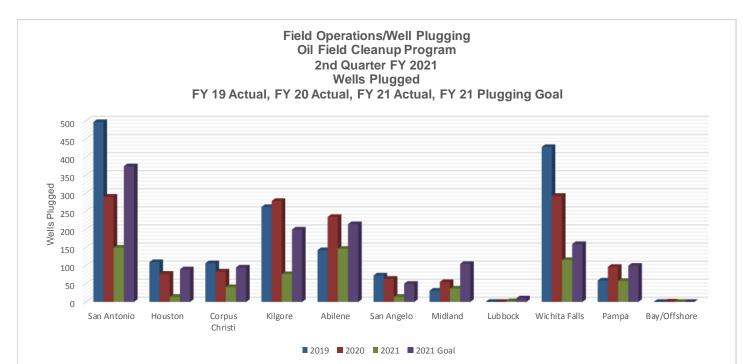
SUBJECT: Oil Field Cleanup Program Quarterly Status Report, Fiscal Year 2021, 2nd Quarter

**Well Plugging:** The 2nd quarter performance for State-Managed Plugging includes 383 wells plugged with a total expenditure of \$7,683,547.42 using Oil and Gas Regulation and Cleanup (OGRC) and General Revenue funds. This includes wells that have been physically plugged, invoiced by the plugging contractor, and approved for payment by Field Operations. Additionally, during the 2nd quarter, 320 wells were approved for plugging with State funds. A total of 859 wells were physically plugged through the end of the 2nd quarter, of which, 656 have been invoiced and paid. The actual wells plugged and expenditure by district for fiscal years 2019, 2020 and 2021 and the well plugging goals and budgets by district for fiscal year 2021 are shown on the attached graphs. The fiscal year 2021 budget is \$34,550,000.

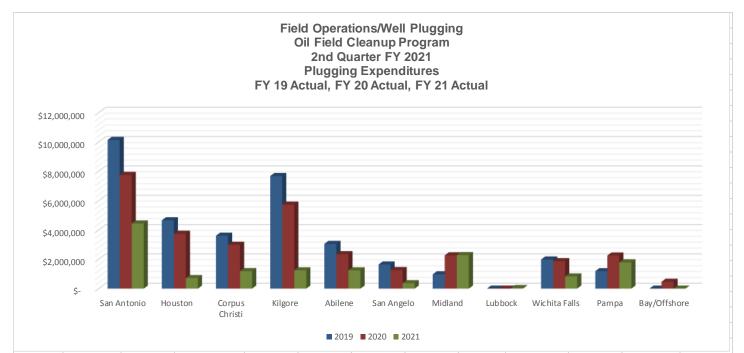
**Site Remediation:** The 2nd quarter performance for Site Remediation includes 50 cleanup activities completed with a total expenditure of \$509,949.20 using OGRC funds and one cleanup activity completed with total expenditures of \$5,845.58 using grant funds. Additionally, during the 2nd quarter 106 cleanup activities were authorized for cleanup with State funds. Through the end of the 2nd quarter, Site Remediation has completed and formally closed a total of 88 cleanup activities using OGRC funds and 1 activity with Grant Funds for a total of 89 completed activities. The actual remediation activities and expenditure by district for fiscal years 2019, 2020, and 2021 and the goals for the Site Remediation activities by district for fiscal year 2021 are shown on the attached graphs. The fiscal year 2021 budget is \$13,807,580.30.
